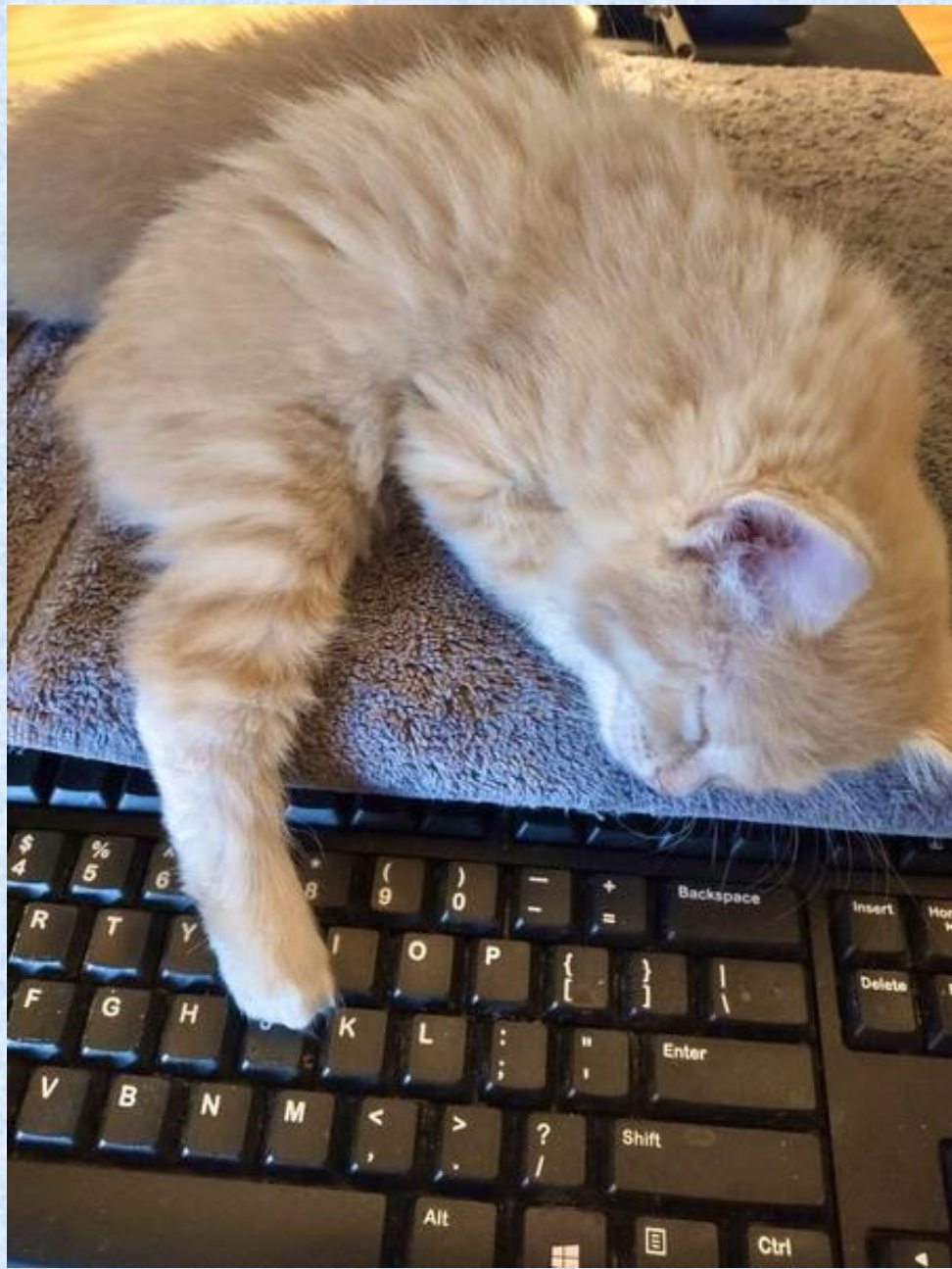

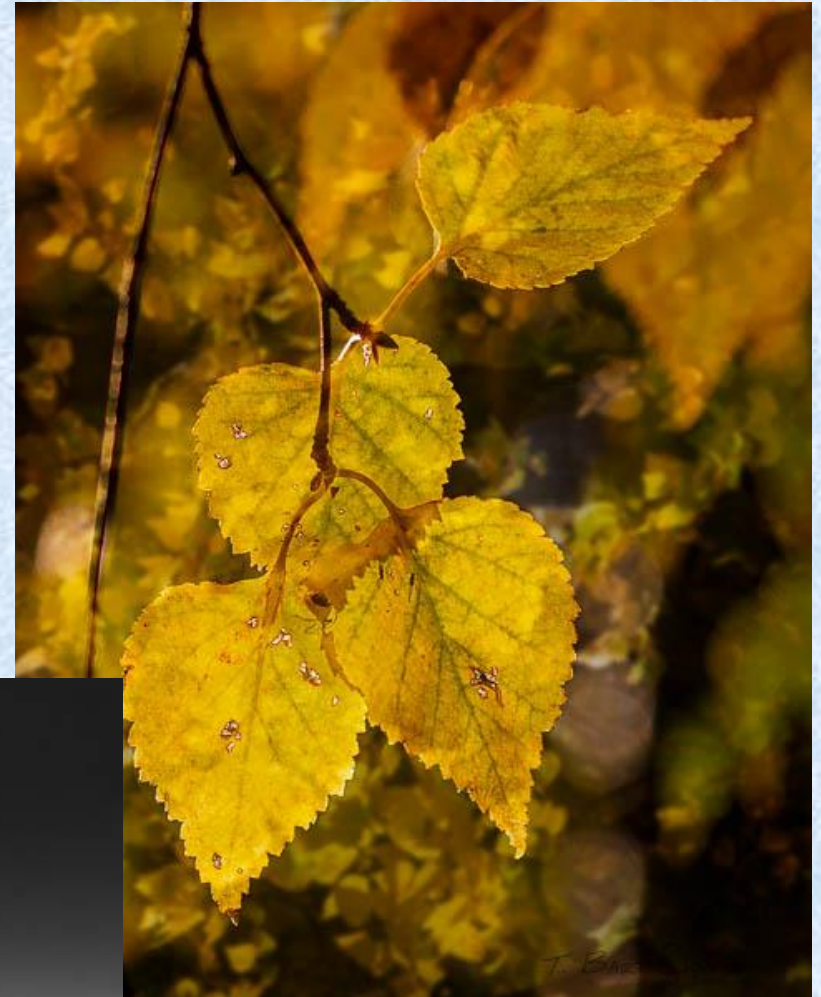

Created still life are images where you have taken the time to arrange the items and lighting artfully.



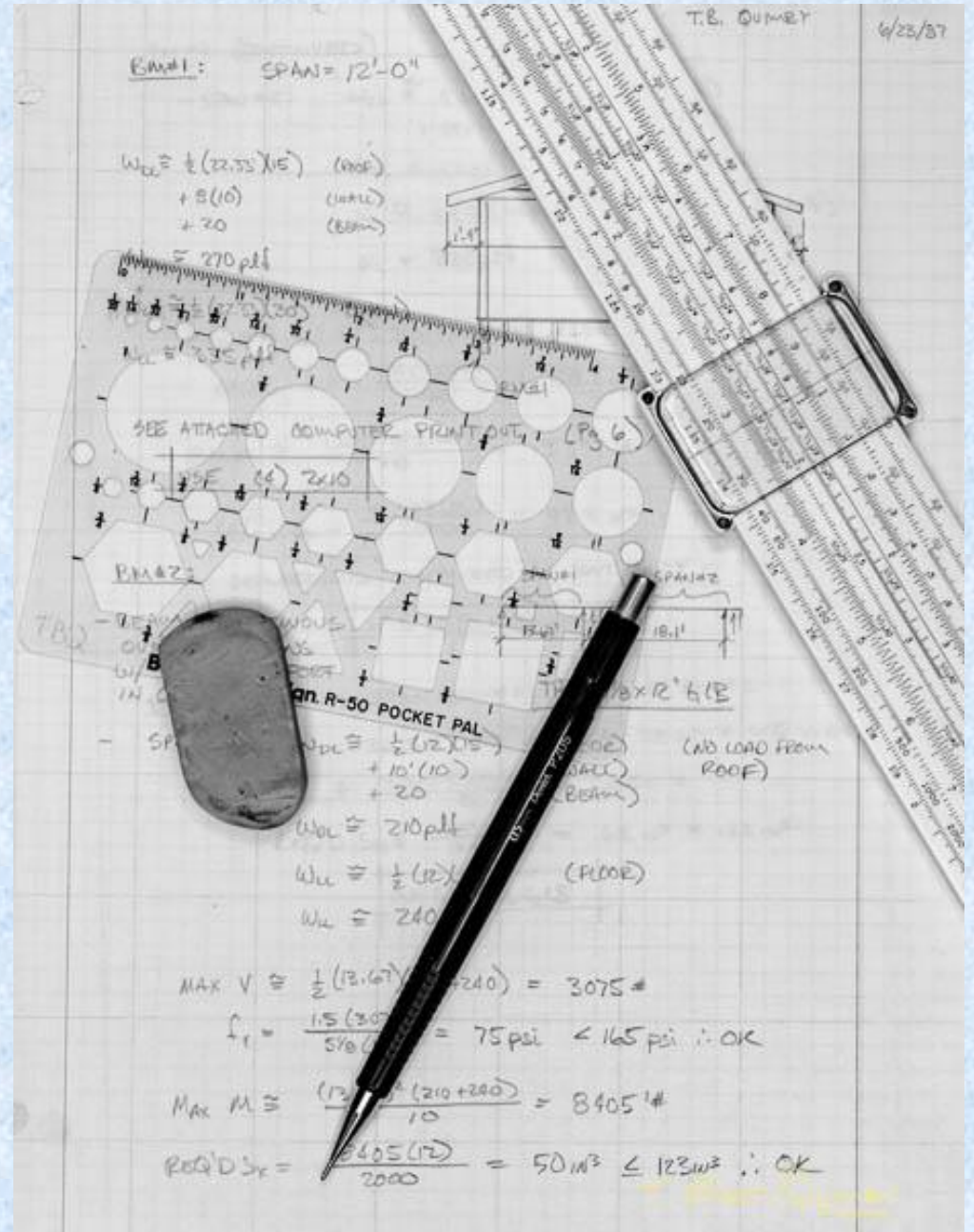
