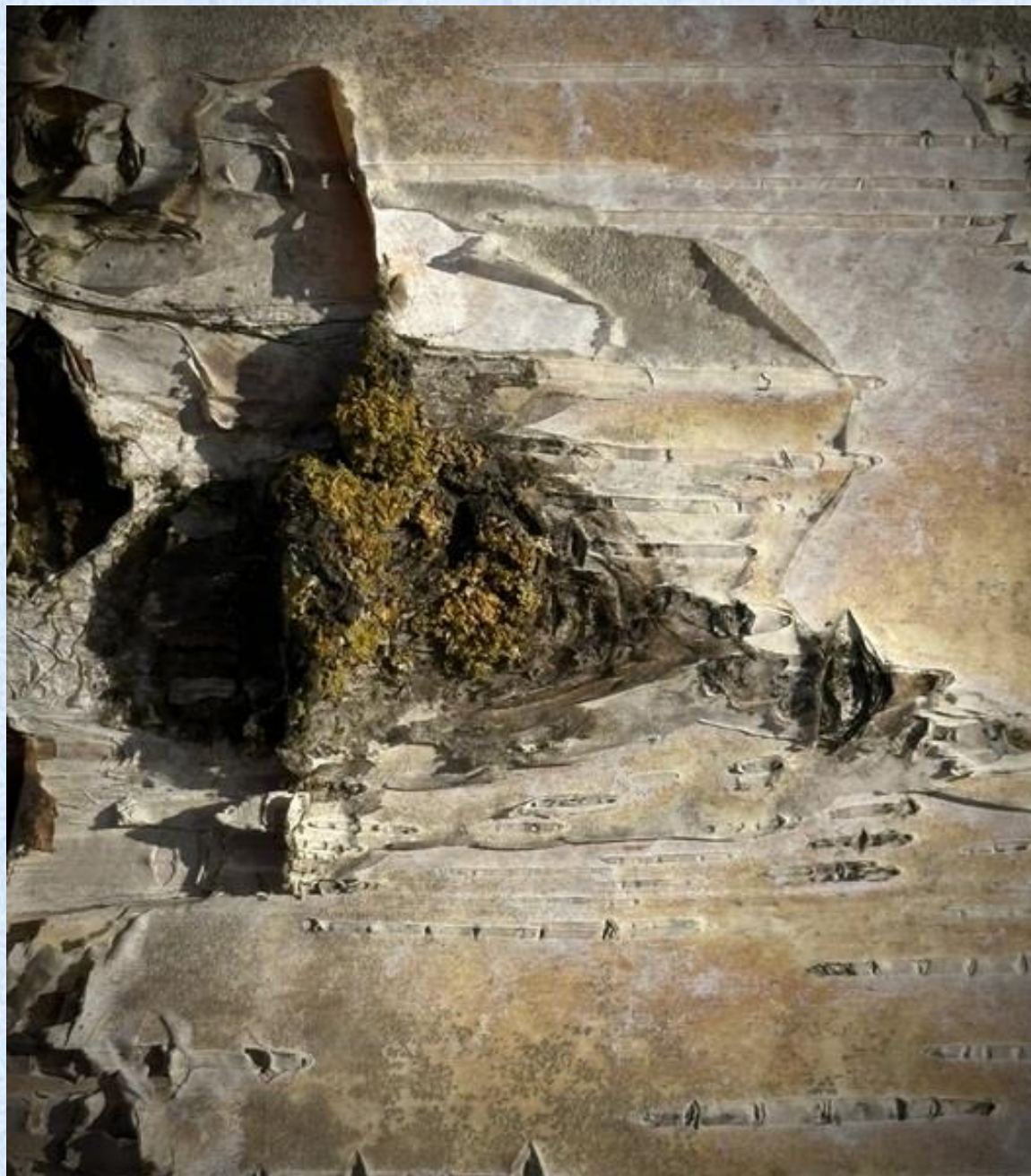

4. Kristina Ahlnas: something on the ground

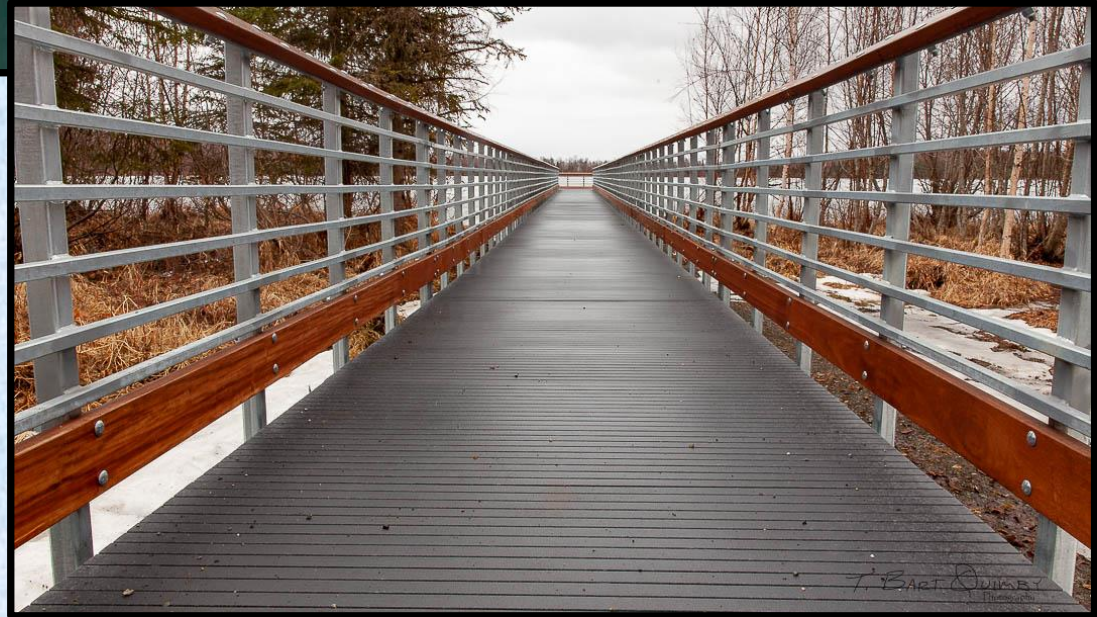
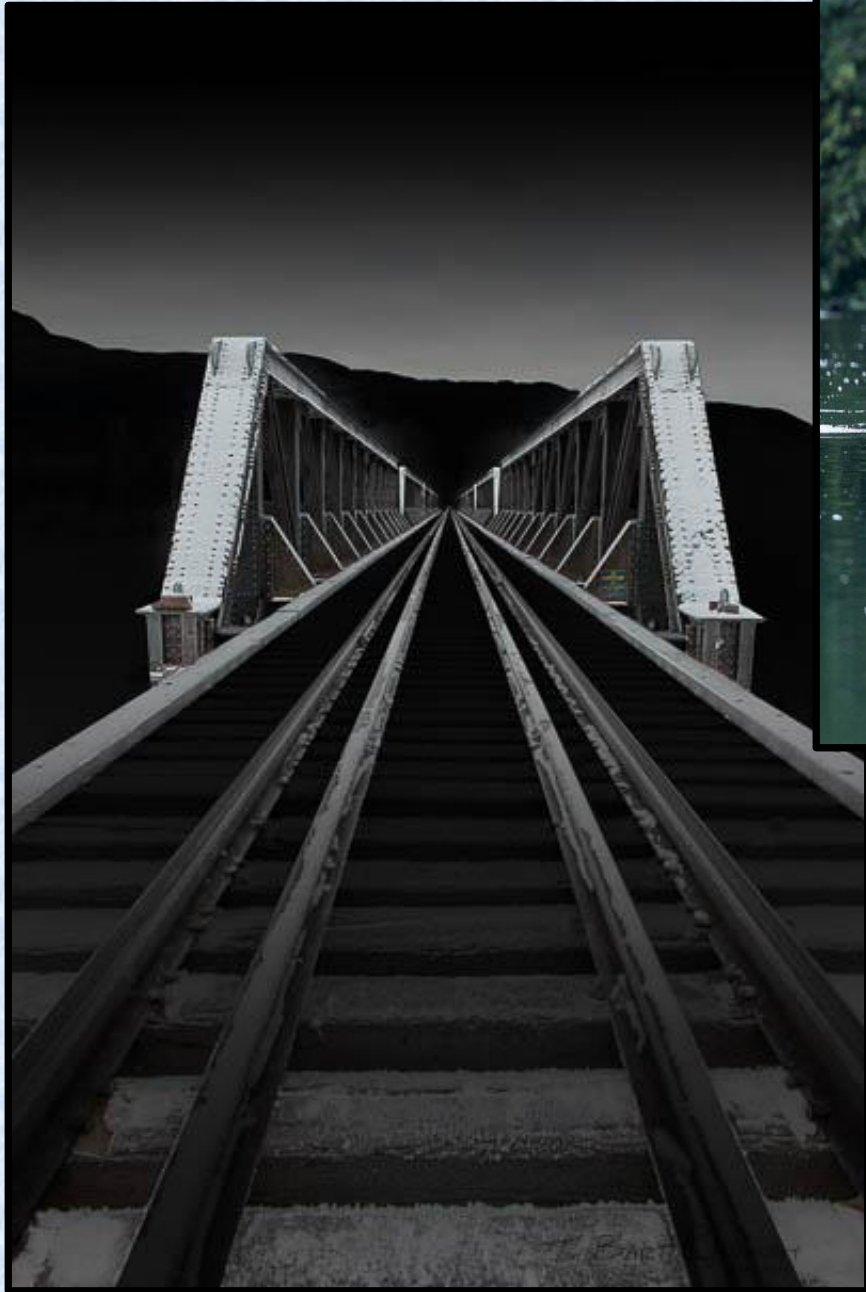

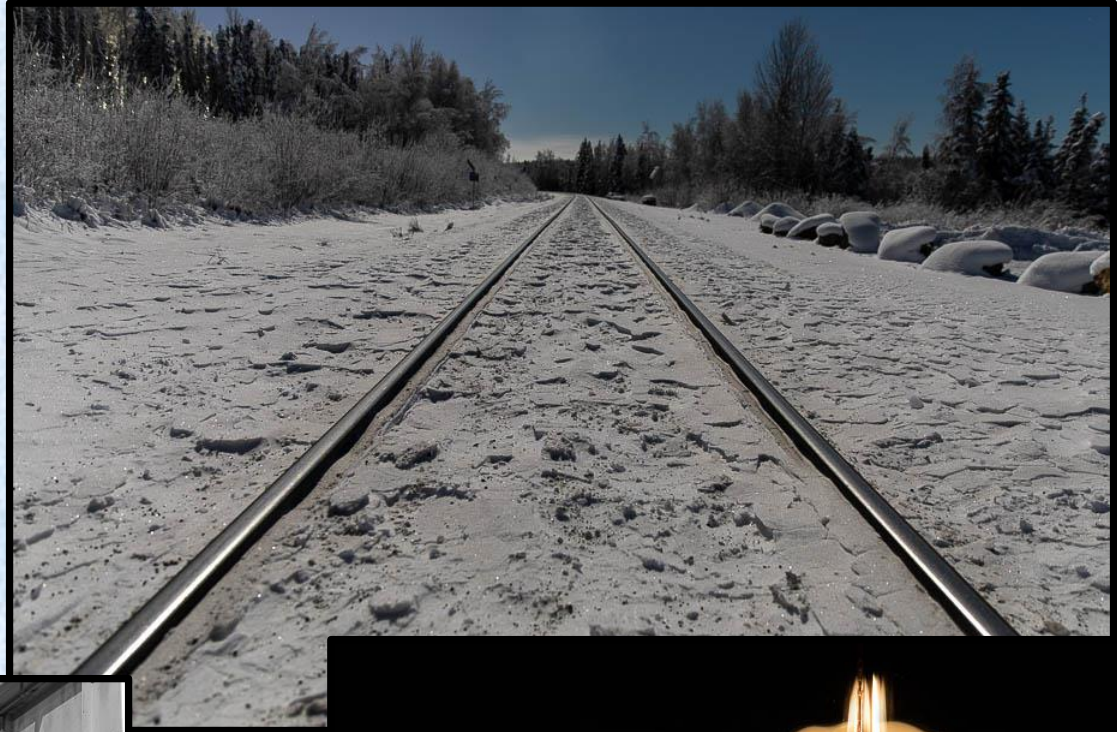
Create an interesting image that either shows symmetry or patterns (or both!).

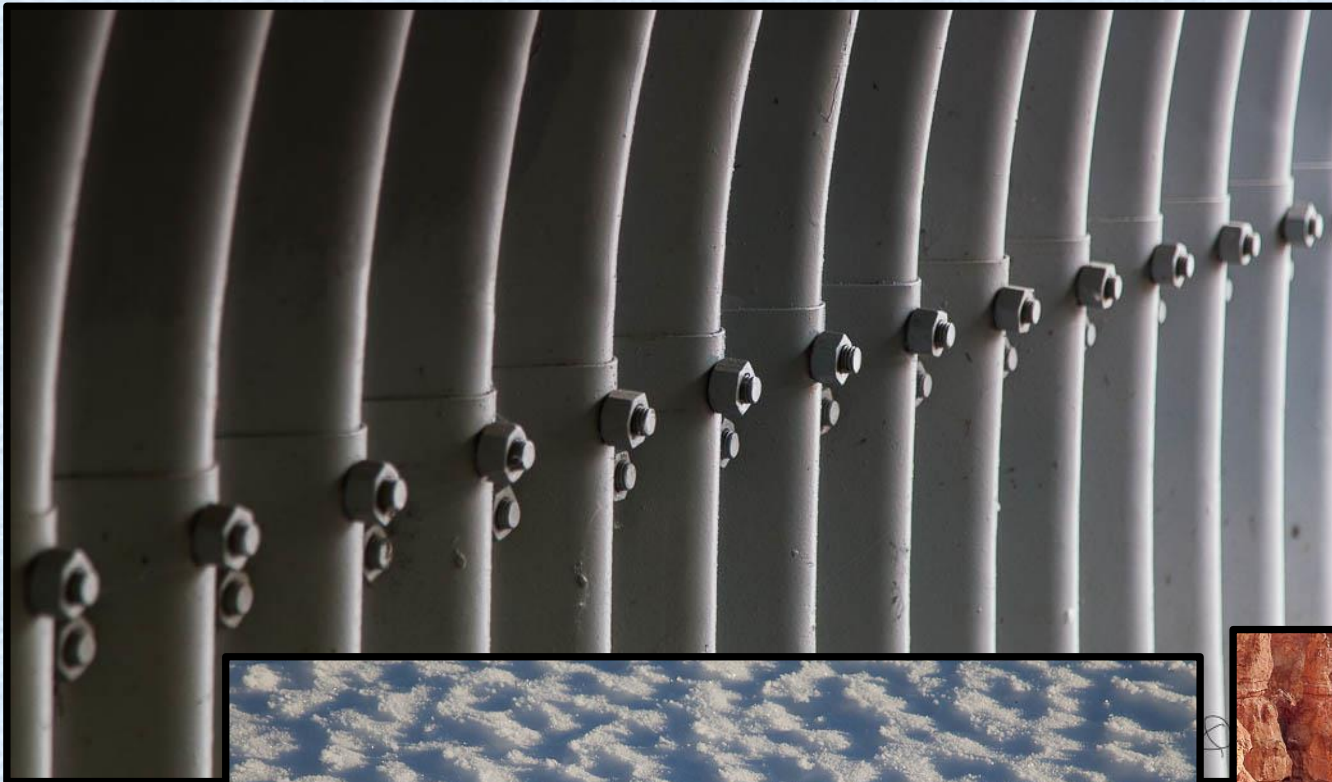

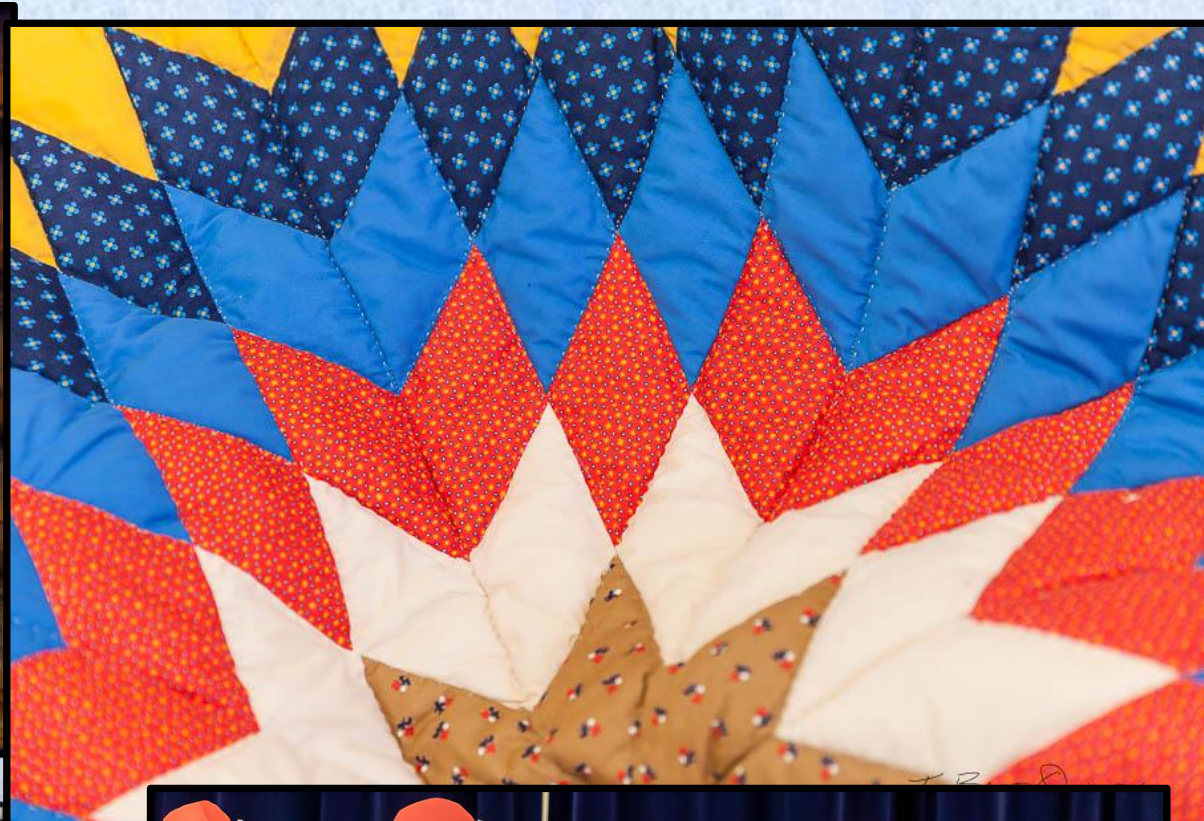
