EQUIPMENT

The best camera you have at any point in time is the one in your hand.

Every camera has its limitations.

You can compose great shots with any camera.

For certain types of shots, you may need specialized equipment such as tripods, filters, or lenses.



POST PROCESSING

Almost every digital device has some kind of photo editing capabilities

There are lots of free apps in addition to the expensive ones

Even minor photo editing efforts can dramatically enhance your image

- Cropping
- Color adjustment
- Creative filters
- And more...
