The number of lines in a starburst effect depends on the number of aperture blades in your camera lens. An even number of blades produces the same number of starburst points, while an odd number of blades creates double that number of points. For example, a lens with 8 blades will have an 8-pointed starburst, and one with 9 blades will have an 18-pointed starburst.
