How to Upload your Images

How to upload your images


- Know where your images are on your computing device
- Open a browser and go to <https://qfam.org/PhotoAssign/> for the upload link for the course
- I will send this link out in all Blast emails


Once you click on the upload link, you should get a window that looks something like this.

You have two choices for uploading files.

First option is to click on the “Add files” then navigate to where your image(s) are on your device and select them.

The second option is to have this window open and window in your file manager then select and drag your images from the file manager to the dropbox window.



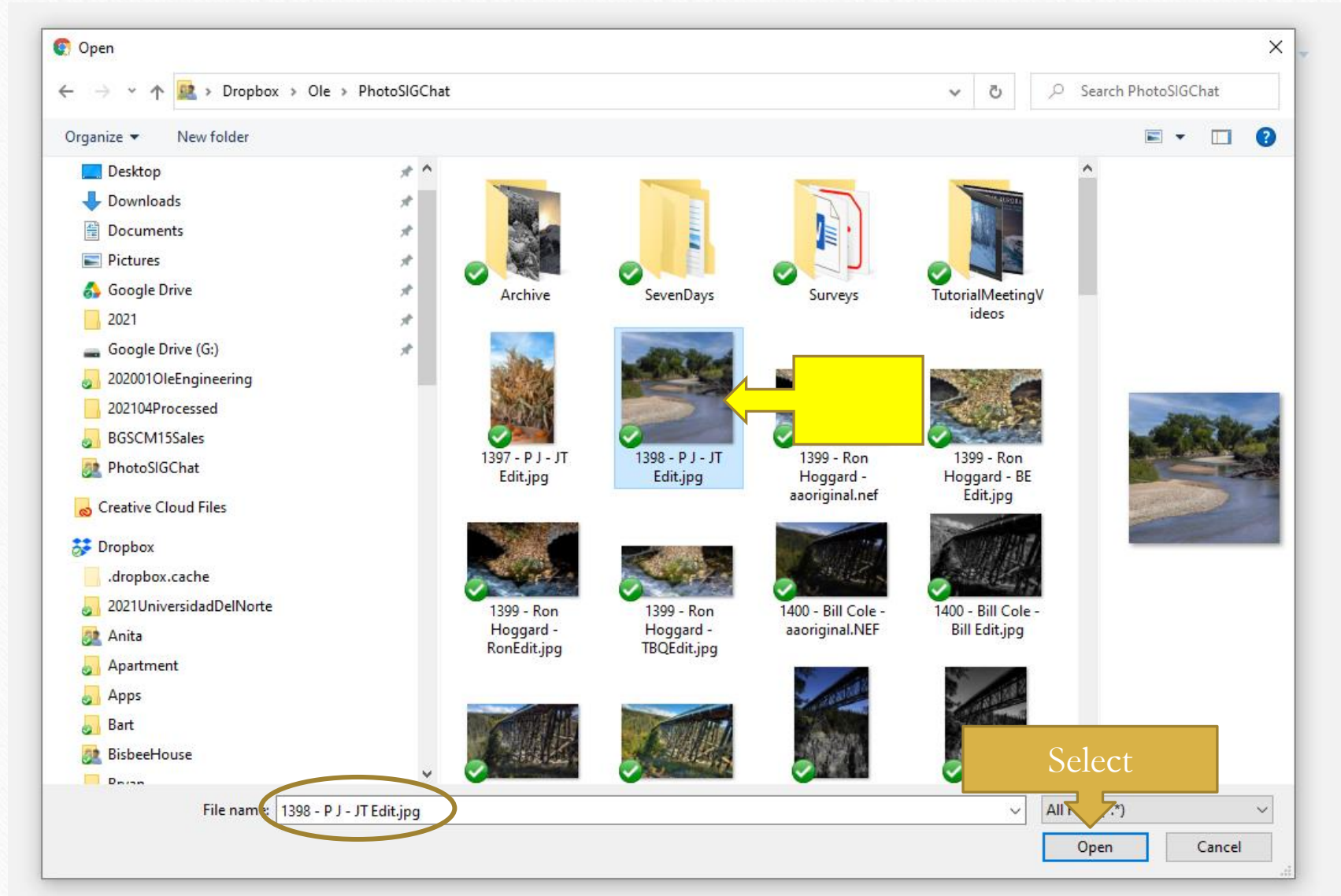
